

## **President**

### **VPs:**

Academic Affairs (Provost);  
Financial Affairs;  
Student Activities and Admissions;  
(Governmental Relations and Community Engagement) and others as President sees fit.

**3 Academic Affairs Deans.** Each is a member of the Academic Affairs VP's "Academic Affairs Cabinet."  
The 3 deans are, respectively, deans of:

### **Degrees & Curricular Concerns**

Serves as [or oversees the] Director of General Education Assessment  
Serves as [or oversees the] Director of Teaching Support (Scheduling, facilitating team-teaching, ensuring pedagogical/laboratory needs)  
Oversees the:  
Office of Curricular Support (Student Requests; transfer/study away; 2+2's; Catalog)  
Office of Student Academic Success (Coaches/Advising; Graduation/Retention)  
Office of Accreditations and Reports (Education program and periodic campus-wide accreditations; Institutional Research)

### **Faculty Relations**

In charge of P&T, annual/periodic review, appointments, Work Plans; [Grievances?])

### **Projects, Centers, & Student Engagement**

Serves as point for various "centers" on campus (those not in clusters); application/funding for cluster projects; focus on student involvement in clusters and projects.

Each of the 7 Clusters would have:

#### **Director of \_\_ Cluster Relations.** (1-1 teaching load?)

Liaison with other 6 Cluster counterparts;  
Sit on the Academic Affairs Cabinet;  
Consultant to/agent of the Dean of Faculty Relations.  
Charged with ensuring excellent teaching in programs within cluster.  
Charged with building a sense of community within the cluster's faculty and students.  
Facilitator of Clustered Scholarship and Service, internally and externally partnered.

#### **Director of \_\_ Cluster Curricular Affairs.** (2-2 teaching load?)

Liaison with other 6 cluster counterparts;  
Consultant to/agent of Dean of Degrees & Curricular Concerns.  
Facilitator of Cluster's programmatic needs.  
Facilitator of Cluster's commitment to General Education

**Program Coordinators** (4-4 teaching load; semester-by-semester supplemental pay)

### **Faculty**
