Thanks for submitting an Integrated Cluster project proposal. We appreciate your ideas and investment of time in this new process.

This project will incorporate the expertise of faculty as well as exterior professionals to talk about and exhibit what excites them about their work in relation to the topic of Forecasting: Climate Change and Water Impact. This is a great example of bringing big world problems and concepts to the PSU community. In reviewing the project proposal, we noted student participation was geared towards responses to the exhibit and this was a concern. Student participation should not be a secondary aspect of the project. Instead, students should play a role in the creation of the project. The exhibits presently on display in the Museum of the White Mountains and the Karl Drerup Art Gallery both have these active elements where students are a part of the project creation. We encourage the group to meet and discuss how this student element can be increased and resubmit the proposal in December.

Considerations:

- Can student work be more public, either as part of the exhibit itself or in some other way?
- Can the students work with the videographer in the creation of the video?
- Can there be an online public space where student work is displayed?

There will be one more active cycle of applications in December and we encourage you to resubmit the project making students a larger part of it.
